Dear Mr. Sanders:

Thank you for your June 12, 1985, letter concerning the disposal of shower water used by personnel involved in asbestos abatement. You ask if there are any regulations prohibiting disposal of this water into the normal sewer lines.

Shower water is not regulated by the asbestos National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), 40 CFR 61.140, et seq. In addition, I have determined that the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has no other regulations which would prohibit disposal of this water into the sewer.
